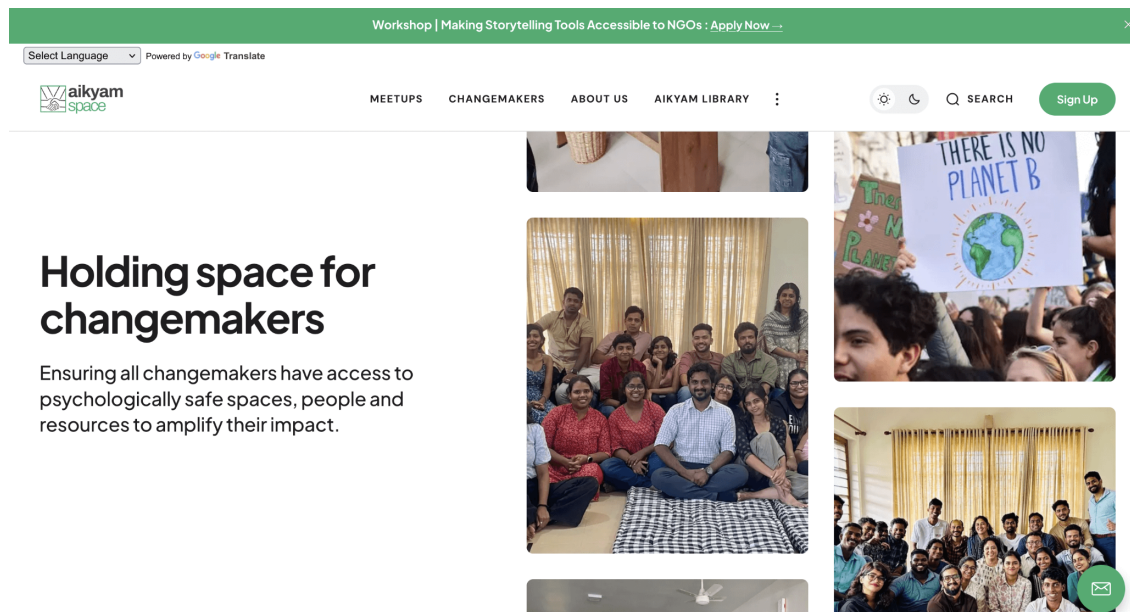
2. Curriculum for fellows

- We designed a 1-Year Diploma Programme to help other organisations and institutions deliver the aikyam fellowship model.

 - Data collection and analysis: from paper to digital

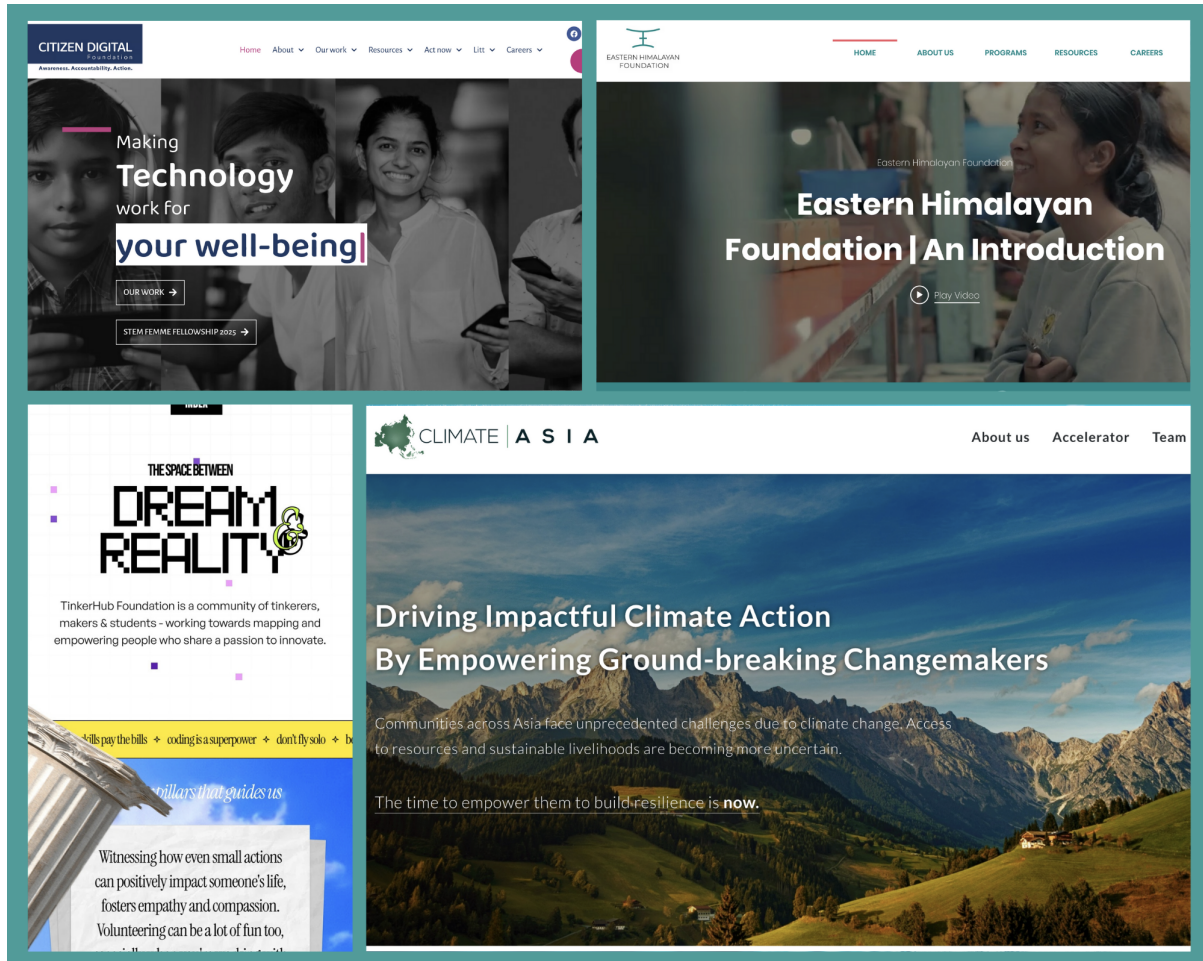
4. aikyam space

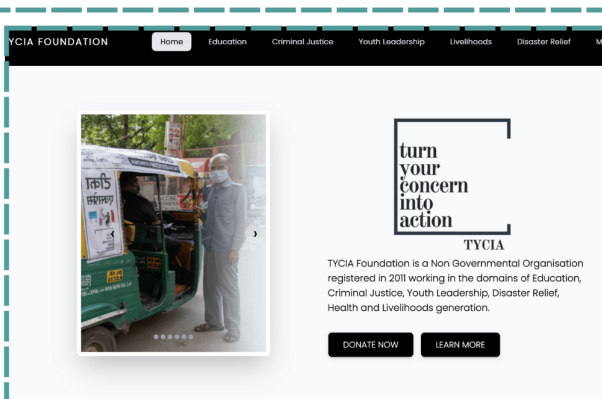


Welcome!
